#### Message for parents of current Year 5 - secondary school admissions

Parents of pupils in the current Year 5 should be starting to think about their choices for secondary school admissions. The application period to Birmingham City Council Admissions will open at the beginning of September and close at the end of October. Secondary schools will hold their open days/evenings early in the Autumn Term; it is really important that you and your child look around any schools that you may be interested in. It is also important that you consider your home address and whether or not you have any faith claim when deciding on your choices. It is important to make realistic applications.

If you are interested in applying for your child to sit a grammar school entrance test, you will need to register on this website: <u>www.westmidlandsgrammarschools.co.uk</u>

The closing date for registration for grammar schools is 4pm on 28th June. The entrance test will take place on 14th September.
