
Dear Parents & Carers,

Parking - a very difficult situation

As a school, we are in a very precarious situation when it comes to parking. It is important that you are aware that St Nicholas Catholic Primary School <u>does not have a car park of its own</u>. We do not control any of the land past the front curb of the school - this is all Parish land. Motorists who receive parking fines from the cameras in the parish car park are finding that it is increasingly difficult to get them reversed. School staff have received fines as have people coming to visit or work in our school.

We have now received an email from the Sutton Park Hotel Pub stating that they are irritated by the number of parents parking in their car park and that they will refuse to cancel car parking fines incurred in the pub car park unless the motorist can provide proof of purchase within the establishment.

On top of this, we have had a very irate altercation with a resident of Wakefield Close who took issue to the use of the back gates when the playground was opened up as a car park for the New Starters' Disco.

This all adds up to a very difficult car parking situation.

It is important that everyone is safe. So please avoid the parish car park from 8.40am to 9.10am and then from 3.20pm to 3.40pm. Please try to leave yourself enough time in the mornings to find a suitable space in the surrounding roads. We will continue to try to work with our neighbours, including the parish, to alleviate the situation in any way possible.

If you have children who don't attend St Nicholas and you would like a family/sibling photo, please arrive at the school hall at 8.30am. Applications are now open for current Year 6 children to apply to transfer to secondary school in September 2025. Parents/carers can apply up to **11.59 pm on 31 October 2024**.

Applications received after the closing date are treated as 'late applications' and less likely to be offered one of their preferred schools.
