Why a residential trip in Year 5?

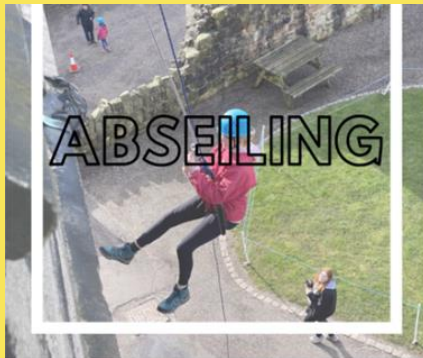
- Residential trips offer activities and experiences that we can't offer on site.
- Children grow in character, independence and confidence.
- A team-building experience before the challenge of Year 6.

Why Alton Castle?

- Established as a residential youth centre by the Archdiocese of Birmingham.
- The mission of the Castle is to promote the personal, spiritual and social development of all children and visitors, its employees and volunteers, through prayer and activity in such a way that they may live life to the full and become fully alive in God.



The children on retreat participate in a variety of activities during their stay. Each activity includes an element of reflection and discussion and prayer, and it is through these activities that each child is challenged and encouraged to find hidden strength, learn new skills, and experience achievement as part of a team and as an individual.



Safety

- The trip is fully risk assessed by St. Nicholas School. Each activity is fully RA by Alton Castle staff (copies on their website).
- Castle staff are DBS checked.
- St. Nicholas staff are first aid trained.
- Risks are identified and measures put in place to mitigate risk.
- Staff members attending are briefed by trip leader before the trip.
- Trip leader is in regular contact with school staff both in and out of school hours.
- Children are not permitted to bring their mobile phones. Staff will communicate with parents where necessary.
- Photos and other updates will be sent out via ParentMail and our school X (formerly Twitter) feed. **@StNicholasCP**

Practical arrangements

- Pupils will need to bring a packed lunch on the day they travel to Alton Castle.
- Please respond to the letter which will be sent out via ParentMail which will ask you to give permission for the trip.

- Please complete a medical form in pack emailed out and return it to school one month before the trip begins.
