

St Nicholas recently underwent a very thorough external review of our safeguarding policies and procedures. This full-day audit was conducted by an ex-headteacher and safeguarding expert.

The auditor praised the senior leadership team for their clear articulation of the safeguarding vision of the school, as well as the strong knowledge of our staff on key policies, procedures, and potential dangers. The review also highlighted how well our pupils understand how to keep themselves safe, as well as the high standards of record-keeping in place.
